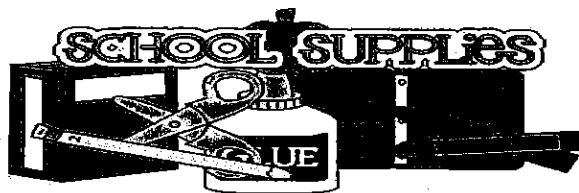
Welcome Summer!
